AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for a Pennsylvania Monuments registration 1
- 2 plate; and further providing for payments to special funds. 3
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- § 1353.1. Pennsylvania Monuments registration plate. 8
- 9 (a) Design. -- The department shall design a Pennsylvania
- 10 Monuments registration plate which shall have a replica of the
- 11 Pennsylvania Memorial Monument at the Gettysburg National
- Military Park and shall display the words "Gettysburg 1863." 12
- (b) Application. -- Upon application of any person, 13
- 14 accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the
- 15 annual registration fee, the department shall issue the
- 16 registration plate under subsection (a) for a passenger car,
- motor home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of 17
- not more than 10,000 pounds. 18

- 1 (c) Use of fee.--The Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg
- 2 National Military Park Trust Fund shall receive \$15 of the fee
- 3 paid by the applicant for the registration plate under
- 4 <u>subsection (a).</u>
- 5 Section 2. Section 1905 of Title 75 is amended by adding a
- 6 subsection to read:
- 7 § 1905. Payments to special funds.

- 9 <u>(d) Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg National Military</u>
- 10 Park Trust Fund. -- The following shall apply:
- 11 (1) There is established a special account in the State
- 12 <u>Treasury which shall be known as the Pennsylvania Monuments</u>
- 13 <u>at Gettysburg National Military Park Trust Fund.</u>
- 14 (2) The Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg National
- Military Park Trust Fund shall be funded from the following
- 16 sources:
- 17 (i) Proceeds paid to the department under section
- 18 1353.1(c) (relating to Pennsylvania Monuments
- 19 <u>registration plate</u>) and contributions made under
- paragraph (3).
- 21 (ii) Grants, gifts, donations and other payments
- from individuals, corporations, other trusts and
- 23 <u>foundations or other legal entities.</u>
- 24 (iii) Funds as may be appropriated to the
- 25 Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg National Military
- 26 Park Trust Fund.
- 27 (3) Beginning as soon as practicable, but not later than
- one year from the effective date of this subsection, the
- 29 <u>department shall provide an applicant for:</u>
- 30 (i) An original or renewal driver's license or

1	<u>identification card with an opportunity to make a</u>
2	contribution of \$2 to the Pennsylvania Monuments at
3	Gettysburg National Military Park Trust Fund. The
4	contribution shall be added to the regular fee for an
5	original or renewal driver's license or identification
6	card. One contribution may be made for each issuance or
7	renewal of a driver's license or identification card.
8	(ii) A renewal vehicle registration with an
9	opportunity to make a contribution of \$2 to the
10	Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg National Military
11	Park Trust Fund. The contribution shall be added to the
12	regular fee for a renewal of a vehicle registration. One
13	contribution may be made for each renewal vehicle
14	registration.
15	(4) All money in the Pennsylvania Monuments at
16	Gettysburg National Military Park Trust Fund is annually
17	appropriated to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
18	Commission to provide grants to nonprofit organizations for
19	the cleaning, repair and restoration of Pennsylvania
20	monuments by the Gettysburg National Military Park. A grant
21	under this paragraph may not be used to pay for the cost of
22	cleaning, repair or restoration of the grounds surrounding a
23	Pennsylvania monument.
24	(5) The Auditor General may conduct audits and reviews
25	of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission's use of
26	grants under this section.
27	(6) The Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission
28	shall establish guidelines for awarding grants under
29	paragraph (4) within 60 days of the effective date of this
3.0	section. The guidelines shall be published as a notice in the

1	Pennsylvania Bulletin and shall not be subject to any of the
2	<pre>following:</pre>
3	(i) Section 205 of the act of July 31, 1968
4	(P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the Commonwealth
5	Documents Law.
6	(ii) Sections 204(b) and 301(10) of the act of
7	October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the
8	Commonwealth Attorneys Act.
9	(iii) The act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181),
10	known as the Regulatory Review Act.
11	(7) Beginning before August 1, 2013, and before each
12	August 1 thereafter, the commission shall submit a report to
13	the majority and minority chairmen of the Veterans Affairs
14	and Emergency Preparedness Committees of the Senate and the
15	majority and minority chairmen of the Veterans Affairs and
16	Emergency Preparedness Committees of the House of
17	Representatives. The report shall detail the sources for and
18	grants made from the Pennsylvania Monuments at Gettysburg
19	National Military Park Trust Fund.
20	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
