AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," further providing for polling places selected by
12 a county board and for regulations for polling places.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 526(a) of the act of June 3, 1937
16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is
17 amended by adding subsections to read:

18 Section 526. Polling Places to Be Selected by County
19 Board.--* * *

20 (d) A polling place selected under this article must be free
21 of all political material on the day of a primary or election.

22 (e) As used in this section, the term "political material"

1 shall mean pamphlets, posters, signs, advertisements or other
2 printed, photographed, painted or written materials or
3 statements, that identify or indicate support for or opposition
4 to a candidate, political party, political body or a ballot
5 question. The term does not include materials prepared by the
6 Secretary of the Commonwealth or a county board of elections
7 under this act.

8 Section 2. Section 1220(c) of the act is amended to read:

9 Section 1220. Regulations in Force at Polling Places.--* * *

10 (c) No person, when within the polling place, shall
11 electioneer or solicit votes for any political party, political
12 body or candidate, nor shall any written, painted or printed
13 matter be posted up within the said room, except as required by
14 this act.

15 * * *

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
