10	(b) DefinitionsThe following words and phrases when used
11	in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this
12	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Health care professional." A person licensed, certified or
14	registered by any of the State boards as defined in this
15	section.
16	"State board." Includes the following departmental

17 administrative boards within the Department of State: the State 18 Board of Medicine, the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the

State Board of Dentistry, the State Board of Podiatry, the State 1 2 Board of Pharmacy, the State Board of Nursing, the State Board 3 of Physical Therapy, the State Board of Occupational Therapy Education and Licensure, the State Board of [Optometrical 4 Examiners, the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home 5 Administrators, the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, the 6 7 State Board of Psychologist Examiners and the State Board of 8 Examiners in Speech-Language and Hearing.] Optometry, the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators, the State 9 Board of Chiropractic, the State Board of Psychology, the State 10 Board of Massage Therapy, State Board of Social Workers, 11 12 Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors, the 13 State Board of Examiners in Speech-Language and Hearing and any 14 other health-related administrative board which issues professional or occupational licenses within the Department of 15

16 <u>State.</u>

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
