- 6 (c) Allocation and appropriation. --
- 7 (1) The surcharge under subsection (a) (1) [shall be 8 allocated as follows:
- 9 (i) One dollar shall be deposited into the Access to

 10 Justice Account.
- The remainder of money] shall be deposited into 11 (ii) 12 a separate reserve account within the Judicial Computer 13 System Augmentation Account. Notwithstanding section 3732 14 (relating to utilization of funds in account), money 15 deposited under this [subparagraph] paragraph is hereby 16 appropriated to the Supreme Court, upon compliance with 17 Article XV of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), 18 known as The Fiscal Code, for the operation of the 19 Judicial Department.
- 20 (2) The fee under subsection (a)(2) shall be deposited 21 into the Criminal Justice Enhancement Account.
- 22 (3) The fee under subsection (a) (3) shall be deposited 23 into the Access to Justice Account.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
