## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, 1 No.1), entitled "An act providing for taxation by school 2 districts, for the State funds formula, for tax relief in 3 first class cities, for school district choice and voter 4 participation, for other school district options and for a 5 task force on school cost reduction; making an appropriation; 6 prohibiting prior authorized taxation; providing for 7 installment payment of taxes; restricting the power of 8 certain school districts to levy, assess and collect taxes; 9 and making related repeals," further providing for public 10 referendum requirements for increasing certain taxes. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 333(f)(2) of the act of June 27, 2006 14 15 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, is amended by adding a subparagraph to read: 16 Section 333. Public referendum requirements for increasing 17 18 certain taxes. \* \* \* 19 20 Referendum exceptions. -- A school district may, without (f) 21 seeking voter approval under subsection (c), increase the rate 22 of a tax levied for the support of the public schools by more

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
