AN ACT

1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial
3 disclosure, further providing for penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1109(f) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1109. Penalties.

10 (f) Civil penalty.--In addition to any other civil remedy or
11 criminal penalty provided for in this chapter, the commission
12 may, after notice has been served in accordance with section
13 1107(5) (relating to powers and duties of commission) and upon a
14 majority vote of its members, levy a civil penalty upon any
15 person subject to this chapter who fails to file a statement of
16 financial interests in a timely manner or who files a deficient
17 statement of financial interests, at a rate of not more than \$25
18 for each day such statement remains delinquent or deficient. The
19 maximum penalty payable under this paragraph is [~~\$250~~] \$2,000.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
