AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled  
2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration  
3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery  
4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of  
5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes  
6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"  
7 further providing for powers and duties of secretary.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 303(a)(11)(iv) of the act of August 26,  
11 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, amended  
12 June 30, 2011 (P.L.110, No.23), is amended to read:

13 Section 303. Powers and duties of secretary.

14 (a) Powers and duties enumerated.--In addition to the powers  
15 and duties provided by law and the act of April 9, 1929  
16 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, the  
17 secretary shall have the power and it shall be his duty to  
18 operate and administer the lottery, and to promulgate rules and  
19 regulations governing the establishment and operation thereof,  
20 including, but not limited to:

2 (11) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing  
3 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other  
4 sources among:

5 \* \* \*

6 (iv) for property tax relief and free or reduced  
7 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in  
8 section 311. For fiscal years beginning before July 1,  
9 2015, no less than 27% of the total revenues accruing  
10 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be  
11 dedicated to this subparagraph. For fiscal years  
12 beginning after June 30, 2015, no less than [30%] 25% of  
13 the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery  
14 tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this  
15 subparagraph.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
