11	Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
12	provisions of this part which are applicable to specific
13	provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when
14	used in this part shall have the meanings given to them in this
15	section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

17	"Storm water facility." A basin, pond, ditch, drain, swale,
18	culvert, pipe or other manmade feature of land which was

constructed to temporarily or permanently convey or store storm 1 2 water. Section 2. Section 7302(a)(2) of Title 68 is amended to 3 4 read: § 7302. Application of chapter. 5 6 General rule.--This chapter shall apply to all (a) 7 residential real estate transfers except the following: * * * 8 9 (2)Transfers of new residential construction that has not been previously occupied when: 10 11 the buyer has received a one-year or longer (i) written warranty covering such construction; 12 13 the dwelling has been inspected for compliance (ii) 14 with the applicable building code or, if there is no 15 applicable code, for compliance with a nationally 16 recognized model building code; [and] (iii) a certificate of occupancy or a certificate of 17 18 code compliance has been issued for the dwelling[.]; and 19 (iv) the dwelling is not located on a property 20 containing any part of a storm water facility. * * * 21 Section 3. Disclosure form. 24 25 * * * 26 (b) Contents of property disclosure statement. -- The form of property disclosure statement promulgated by the State Real 27 28 Estate Commission shall call for disclosures with respect to all 29 of the following subjects: 30 * * *

4 facilities, including a statement disclosing whether ongoing

Section 3. For the purpose of implementing the amendment or 9 addition of 68 Pa.C.S. § 7304(b)(13) and (17), revisions to the 10 property disclosure statement shall be promulgated by the State 11 Real Estate Commission within 120 days of the effective date of 12 13 this section as a final-form FINAL-OMITTED regulation under the <--14 act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the Regulatory Review Act, with notice of proposed rulemaking omitted under 15 section 204 of the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), 16 17 referred to as the Commonwealth Documents Law. 18 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
