AN ACT

1 Providing for the highway capital budget project itemization for
2 the fiscal year 2014-2015 to be financed from current revenue
3 or by the incurring of debt.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 CHAPTER 1

7 GENERAL PROVISIONS

8 Section 101. Short title.

9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Highway
10 Capital Budget Project Itemization Act of 2014-2015.

11 Section 102. Total authorization.

12 The total authorization for the capital projects itemized in
13 Chapter 3 to be constructed by the Department of Transportation,
14 its successors or assigns and to be financed by the incurring of
15 debt or from current revenues of the Motor License Fund shall be
16 \$0,000,000,000.

17 Section 103. Itemization of public highway projects.

18 Additional capital projects in the category of public highway

1 projects to be constructed by the Department of Transportation,
2 its successors or assigns and to be financed by the incurring of
3 debt of from current revenues of the Motor License Fund are
4 itemized in Chapter 3, together with their respective estimated
5 financial costs.

13 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

14 Section 701. Debt authorization.

15 The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
16 authorized and directed to borrow from time to time, in addition
17 to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted, on the
18 credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations provided
19 in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in the
20 aggregate the sum of \$0,000,000,000 as may be found necessary to
21 carry out the acquisition and construction of the State projects
22 specifically itemized in this act.

23 Section 702. Issue of bonds.

24 The indebtedness authorized in this act shall be incurred
25 from time to time and shall be evidenced by one or more series
26 of general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such
27 aggregate principal amount for each series as the Governor,
28 Auditor General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the
29 latest stated maturity date shall not exceed 30 years from the
30 date of the bond first issued for each series.

1 Section 703. Estimated useful life of projects.

2 The General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the
3 projects itemized in this act as 30 years.

4 Section 704. Appropriation.

5 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations authorized in
6 this act are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
7 Fund to the Department of Transportation in the maximum amount
8 of \$0,000,000,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the
9 financial costs of the State projects specifically itemized in
10 this capital budget. After reserving or paying the expenses of
11 the sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer shall pay out to
12 the Department of Transportation the moneys as required and
13 certified by it to be legally due and payable.

14 Section 705. Federal funds.

15 In addition to those funds appropriated in Chapter 3, all
16 moneys received from the Federal Government for the projects
17 specifically itemized in this act are also hereby appropriated
18 for those projects.

19 Section 706. Allocation of funds.

20 Whenever as determined by the Department of Transportation
21 that the full estimated financial costs of the projects itemized
22 in this act are not necessary for the proper design, acquisition
23 or construction of such projects, the excess funds no longer
24 required may be allocated by the Department of Transportation to
25 increase the estimated costs of any one or more of the projects
26 specifically itemized in a capital budget.

27 Section 707. Editorial changes.

28 In editing and preparing this act for printing following the
29 final enactment, the Legislative Reference Bureau shall insert
30 or revise letters or numbers for projects where the letters or

1 numbers are missing or require revision. The bureau shall also
2 revise the total monetary amounts for the total authorization,
3 debt authorization, appropriations and departmental totals as
4 necessary to agree with the total monetary amounts of the
5 projects.

6 Section 708. Effective date.

7 This act shall take effect immediately.
