## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Urging the Commonwealth to upgrade its broadband communications network for use by the private and public sectors in the Northern Tier of this Commonwealth.
4	WHEREAS, Many of the SOME communities in the region of this <
5	Commonwealth referred to as the Northern Tier lack competitive
6	access to broadband communications and wireless phone services
7	in the region, which impedes the speed of response in matters of
8	public safety, economic development and research, analysis and
9	education; and
10	WHEREAS, The Marcellus Shale natural gas industry is actively
11	developing extensive operations in the Northern Tier and lacks
12	access to adequate broadband communications and wireless phone
13	services in the region SOME AREAS, impacting the speed and
14	effectiveness of industry development; and
15	WHEREAS, The wireless communications industry did not have

16 great financial incentive in the past to develop infrastructure

- 1 to improve coverage in the Northern Tier because of limited
- 2 population; however, utilizing AND
- 3 WHEREAS, THE PROVISIONS OF 66 PA.C.S. § 3014 (RELATING TO
- 4 NETWORK MODERNIZATION PLANS) REQUIRE THE UNIVERSAL DEPLOYMENT OF

- 5 BROADBAND TO THE NORTHERN TIER; AND
- 6 WHEREAS, TWENTY-NINE RURAL LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIERS COMPLETED
- 7 THEIR 100% BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT BY DECEMBER 31, 2008; AND
- 8 WHEREAS, TWO RURAL LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIERS ARE SCHEDULED TO
- 9 COMPLETE 100% BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT BY DECEMBER 31, 2013; AND
- 10 WHEREAS, THE REMAINING LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIER IS SCHEDULED TO
- 11 COMPLETE ITS 100% BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT NO LATER THAN DECEMBER
- 12 31, 2015; AND
- 13 WHEREAS, 4G LTE WIRELESS BROADBAND TECHNOLOGY IS BEING
- 14 DEPLOYED IN THE NORTHERN TIER TO HELP COMPLETE THAT REQUIREMENT;
- 15 AND
- 16 WHEREAS, UTILIZING Commonwealth-owned infrastructure and
- 17 wireless communications, industry can SOME CARRIERS MAY BE ABLE <--
- 18 TO eliminate much of its THEIR upfront infrastructure
- 19 development costs and more effectively cover the region with its-<--
- 20 THEIR services to meet the expanding communications needs; and <-
- 21 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth owns and maintains a vast number of
- 22 communications towers and related infrastructure across the
- 23 Northern Tier that must be upgraded to adequately support
- 24 multiple Commonwealth needs for enhanced broadband
- 25 communications in the region; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Financial, engineering and construction support from
- 27 wireless communications and natural gas industries could be
- 28 provided to ensure that the Commonwealth's communications tower
- 29 sites, related facilities and resulting broadband communications
- 30 network meet or exceed their industries' highest quality control

- 1 and performance standards to maximize their effective, long-term
- 2 use; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The resulting broadband communications network would
- 4 significantly benefit all pertinent Commonwealth agencies,
- 5 authorities, boards, commissions, councils, departments, offices
- 6 and communities in the region and the development of regional
- 7 business and industry, including, but not limited to, the
- 8 Marcellus Shale natural gas industry and wireless communications
- 9 industry; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The community, business and industry safety,
- 11 economic development, research analysis and educational
- 12 opportunities are of paramount importance; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth should encourage, invite and guide
- 14 wireless communications and natural gas industry collaboration
- 15 to facilitate the most mutually advantageous outcome to all
- 16 parties in the Northern Tier; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 18 Commonwealth to upgrade its broadband communications network for
- 19 use by the private and public sectors in the Northern Tier of
- 20 this Commonwealth.
