A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of October 7 through 13, 2013, as "National Midwifery Week" in Pennsylvania. 2
- WHEREAS, This year, National Midwifery Week will be 3
- celebrated during the week of October 7 through 13, 2013; and 4
- 5 WHEREAS, The American College of Nurse-Midwives,
- headquartered in Silver Spring, Maryland, is the official 6
- 7 national organization for the nearly 12,000 certified nurse-
- 8 midwives and certified midwives throughout the United States and
- the official sponsor of National Midwifery Week on the national
- level; and 10
- 11 WHEREAS, This national event is an opportunity for women
- 12 across the United States to gather for education and celebration
- 13 of the health care service provided by midwives; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Midwives have been a vital and growing part of the
- advancement of women's health in Pennsylvania since 1929 and 15
- were collectively responsible for 13,922 births in 2010, or more

- 1 than 9.7% of all births in Pennsylvania; and
- 2 WHEREAS, National Midwifery Week acknowledges the important
- 3 role midwives play in women's lives. Whether assisting a woman
- 4 as she gives birth or providing personalized, well-woman health
- 5 care, midwives are truly partners with women in making health
- 6 care decisions; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 8 week of October 7 through 13, 2013, as "National Midwifery Week"
- 9 in Pennsylvania.
