## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of October 2014 as "Archives Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The historical documents and records of our nation
- 4 and our Commonwealth provide a crucial link to our past; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the growing
- 6 importance of maintaining its own legislative, committee and
- 7 individual member records for posterity; and
- 8 WHEREAS, For more than 35 years, the Archives of the House of
- 9 Representatives has served as the official archival repository
- 10 for the records of elected members, committees and
- 11 administrative agencies of that body; and
- 12 WHEREAS, These historical records and documents, if not
- 13 professionally collected, cataloged and preserved by dedicated
- 14 archivists and staff and housed in a secure location, would be
- 15 lost to future generations of our citizens; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Archives of the House of Representatives seeks
- 2 to share the valuable historical information and documents in
- 3 its holdings with researchers, legislators, staff members and
- 4 the public; and
- 5 WHEREAS, These records are accessible through many programs,
- 6 including the collection of House Committee records from 1971 to
- 7 the present, an interactive online biographical directory of
- 8 members dating from 1900 to the present and an extensive
- 9 collection of oral history interviews with legislators, which
- 10 include first-hand accounts of life as a legislator, providing
- 11 scholars and citizens alike with the ability to consult and
- 12 utilize these historically valuable resources; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 14 invaluable contribution of its archival repository and its
- 15 committed staff members; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 17 month of October 2014 as "Archives Month" in Pennsylvania; and
- 18 be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 20 Pennsylvanians to visit their local archives, historical
- 21 repositories and libraries to learn more about the contributions
- 22 of historical documents and records to the discovery of the rich
- 23 heritage of this Commonwealth.
