- 6 Section 1. The definitions of "perpetrator" and "person
- 7 responsible for the child's welfare" in section 6303(a) of Title

- 11 (a) General rule. -- The following words and phrases when used
- 12 in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 13 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 15 "Perpetrator." A person who has committed child abuse [and
- 16 is a parent of a child, a person responsible for the welfare of
- 17 a child, an individual residing in the same home as a child or a

1	paramour of a child's parent]. The term includes only the	<
2	<u>following:</u>	
3	(1) A parent of the child.	
4	(2) A spouse or former spouse of a parent of the child.	
5	(3) A paramour or former paramour of the parent.	
6	(4) An individual who is 14 years of age or older and:	
7	(i) resides in the same household as the child;	
8	(ii) is present when and where the alleged child	
9	abuse occurred; or	
10	(iii) is related to the child within the fifth	
11	degree of consanguinity or affinity but does not reside	
12	in the same household as the child.	
13	(5) A person responsible for the child's welfare.	
14	PARAMOUR OF A CHILD'S PARENT.] AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION. THE	<
15	FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:	
16	(1) THE TERM INCLUDES ONLY THE FOLLOWING:

25	WHO RESIDES IN THE SAME HOME AS THE CHILD.	
26	(VI) AN INDIVIDUAL 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO DOES	_
27	NOT RESIDE IN THE SAME HOME AS THE CHILD BUT IS RELATED	
28	WITHIN THE THIRD DEGREE OF CONSANGUINITY OR AFFINITY BY	
29	BIRTH OR ADOPTION TO THE CHILD OR THE SPOUSE, FORMER

2	(2) ONLY THE FOLLOWING MAY BE CONSIDERED A PERPETRATOR
3	FOR FAILING TO ACT, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION:
4	(I) A PARENT OF THE CHILD.
5	(II) A SPOUSE OR FORMER SPOUSE OF THE CHILD'S
6	PARENT.
7	(III) A PARAMOUR OR FORMER PARAMOUR OF THE CHILD'S
8	PARENT.
9	(IV) A PERSON 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND
10	RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S WELFARE.
11	(V) A PERSON 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO RESIDES IN
12	THE SAME HOME AS THE CHILD.
13	"Person responsible for the child's welfare." A person who
14	provides permanent or temporary care, supervision, mental health
15	diagnosis or treatment, training or control of a child in lieu
16	of parental care, supervision and control. [The term does not
17	include a person who is employed by or provides services or
18	programs in any public or private school, intermediate unit or
19	area vocational-technical school.] The term includes an
20	individual who has direct or regular contact with a child
21	through any program, activity or service sponsored by a school,
22	for-profit organization or religious or other not-for-profit
23	organization, regardless of where the child abuse occurs.
