10	Section 1. Section 4(a)(6) of the act of January 25, 1966
11	(1965 P.L.1546, No.541), referred to as the Higher Education
12	Scholarship Law, is amended to read:
13	Section 4. (a) Any student is eligible for consideration
14	for a State scholarship providing:

16	(6) The State scholarship recipient shall be free to
17	[attend] <u>enroll at</u> any approved institution of his choice and
18	apply the scholarship toward the tuition, room, board, books and
19	fees of that institution, regardless of the percentage of credit
20	or clock hours required for completing a program of study

1 <u>through online courses</u>. The institution is not required to 2 accept the scholarship recipient for enrollment, but is free to 3 exact compliance with its own admission requirements, standards 4 and policies.
