## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 9, 2008 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for alternative sources of energy; establishing the Alternative Energy Development Program, the Consumer Energy Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Fund and the 5 Alternative Energy Production Tax Credit Program; and 6 providing for the powers and duties of the Department of 7 Environmental Protection," further providing for Commonwealth Financing Authority. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 307 of the act of July 9, 2008 (1st 13 Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Alternative Energy 14 Investment Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 307. Commonwealth Financing Authority. 15 \* \* \* 16 17 (c.1) Natural gas access. --18 (1) The sum of \$15,000,000 shall be allocated by the 19 authority for grants to schools, hospitals and small 20 businesses to obtain access to natural gas.
