## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 9, 2008 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for alternative sources of energy; establishing the Alternative Energy Development Program, the Consumer Energy Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Program, the Home Energy Efficiency Loan Fund and the 3 5 Alternative Energy Production Tax Credit Program; and providing for the powers and duties of the Department of Environmental Protection," further providing for Commonwealth 8 Financing Authority. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 307 of the act of July 9, 2008 (1st <--13 Sp. Sess., P.L. 1873, No.1), known as the Alternative Energy 14 Investment Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 15 SECTION 1. SECTION 307(C)(1) OF THE ACT OF JULY 9, 2008 (1ST <--16 SP.SESS., P.L.1873, NO.1), KNOWN AS THE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY 17 INVESTMENT ACT, IS AMENDED AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING 18 A SUBSECTION TO READ: Section 307. Commonwealth Financing Authority. 19
