## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the illegal use of laser pointer.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5518. Use of laser pointer.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if that
- 10 person knowingly, with the intent to harass, annoy or alarm,
- 11 shines a laser pointer at another person.
- 12 <u>(b) Grading.--</u>
- (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), an offense
- 14 under subsection (a) is a summary offense.
- 15 (2) If the offense in subsection (a) is committed
- against a person operating a motor vehicle, the offense shall
- be a misdemeanor of the third degree.
- 18 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "laser

- 1 pointer" means a handheld device that emits a laser beam.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
