## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety, 2 by providing for the examination and licensure of those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of barbering; regulating barber shops and barber schools, and students therein; regulating compensation for service rendered; conferring 6 certain powers and duties on the Department of State; and providing penalties," providing for authorization of barber 8 school as institution of postsecondary education. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 11 12 Section 1. The act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), 13 referred to as the Barbers' License Law, is amended by adding a 14 section to read: 15 Section 12.1. A barber school shall be recognized and 16 authorized as an institution of postsecondary education if it 17 meets the the following conditions: 18 (1) The school admits as regular students only those 19 individuals who are either beyond the age of compulsory 20 education or have a high school diploma or a diploma based on passing general educational development (GED) tests or their 21

- 1 <u>equivalent</u>.
- 2 (2) The school is licensed by name and authorized by the
- 3 <u>department and the board under this act to offer one or more</u>
- 4 training programs beyond the secondary level.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
