- laws relating thereto," in medical education loan assistance, further providing for loan guarantor program. 5

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. Section 2212-A(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added
- 11 October 30, 2001 (P.L.828, No.83), is amended and the section is
- 12 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 13 Section 2212-A. Loan quarantor program.
- 14 Establishment of program. -- The agency shall administer a
- 15 loan guarantor program on a Statewide basis. The agency shall
- 16 utilize funds in the Medical School Loan Account to encourage
- 17 eligible applicants to attend an accredited medical college or
- an approved institution of higher learning. 18
- 19 (b) Loan Guarantor Program. -- The Loan Guarantor Program

- 1 shall provide for the following:
- 2 (1) Life of loan servicing.
- 3 (2) Contracting for insurance with a guarantor, approved 4 by the agency, which offers a low-cost loan with competitive
- 5 interest rates and loan fees to eligible applicants.
- 6 (3) Predetermining the eligibility of applicants who
- 7 receive a loan from an offeror to attend an accredited
- 8 medical school or an approved institution of higher learning
- 9 that is insured by a guarantor.
- 10 (4) Evaluating the benefit package of a guarantor for
- 11 adequacy, accessibility and availability of funds necessary
- 12 to provide adequate loss prevention.
- 13 <u>(5) Loan forgiveness.</u>
- 14 * * *
- 15 (j) Loan forgiveness. -- A person who receives a loan under
- 16 this section shall receive loan forgiveness to attend medical
- 17 school, if all of the following requirements are met:
- 18 (1) The person is a graduate of a medical school located
- in this Commonwealth.
- 20 (2) The person practices medicine in this Commonwealth
- for a minimum of ten years. If the person practices medicine
- 22 in this Commonwealth for less than ten years the loan
- forgiveness shall terminate the year preceding the person's
- 24 departure from this Commonwealth.
- 25 (3) The person volunteers at least 100 hours of service
- in the health care field each year in which loan forgiveness
- is requested.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, or
- 29 immediately, whichever is later.
