AN ACT

- Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for change of designation to university.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 6503.1. Change of designation to university.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of this
- 9 chapter or other law or regulation to the contrary, a private
- 10 nonprofit institution, as defined under section 501(c)(3) of the
- 11 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. §
- 12 501(c)(3)), holding a certificate of authority that authorizes
- 13 the conferral, at a minimum, of bachelor's degrees and using the
- 14 designation of "college" may, on and after the effective date of
- 15 this subsection, use the designation of "university" if the
- 16 institution submits a notarized affidavit to the department
- 17 <u>stating:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) As of the date of the affidavit</u> the institution

- fulfills at least two of the three units necessary for an
- 2 institution to be designated as a university, as defined in
- 3 <u>this section.</u>
- 4 (2) The institution's commitment to meet any additional
- 5 <u>unit or other requirement necessary to achieve full</u>
- 6 compliance with the definition contained in this section
- 7 within a five-year period.
- 8 (3) That the institution has been in continuous
- 9 operation in this Commonwealth for the ten years preceding
- 10 the date of the notarized affidavit.
- 11 (4) That during the preceding ten years, the institution
- has maintained accreditation by the Middle States Commission
- on Higher Education or another regional accrediting body
- 14 <u>recognized by the United States Department of Education.</u>
- 15 (5) That the accreditation status of the institution is
- in good standing and is in compliance with all standards
- imposed by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education
- or other regional accrediting body, including, but not
- 19 limited to, periodic reviews and evaluations.
- 20 (6) The intended effective date of the change in
- 21 <u>designation</u>.
- 22 (7) That the institution's board of trustees or similar
- 23 governing body has approved the change in designation.
- 24 (b) Documentation. -- The institution seeking the change in
- 25 designation shall include any and all documentation necessary to
- 26 verify the representations contained in the notarized affidavit.
- 27 (c) Time period to submit affidavit.--The institution must
- 28 submit the notarized affidavit to the department no later than
- 29 <u>90 days before the effective date of the change in designation.</u>
- 30 The notarized affidavit shall be subject to the penalties of 18

- 1 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to
- 2 authorities).
- 3 (d) Review by department.--
- 4 (1) The department shall review the affidavit and
- 5 <u>complete its review within 60 days of receipt of the</u>
- 6 affidavit.
- 7 (2) If the affidavit complies with the requirements of
- 8 this section, the department shall accept the affidavit and
- 9 <u>publish the acceptance as a notice in the Pennsylvania</u>
- 10 Bulletin. The notice shall include the effective date of the
- 11 <u>change in designation.</u>
- 12 (3) If the department fails to complete its review of
- the affidavit within the 60-day time period, the affidavit
- shall be deemed accepted and the department shall publish the
- 15 <u>acceptance as a notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.</u>
- 16 (4) If the affidavit does not comply with the
- 17 <u>requirements of this section, the department shall reject the</u>
- 18 affidavit for noncompliance by returning the affidavit to the
- 19 institution, together with any documentation submitted, and
- 20 shall state the basis for the rejection.
- 21 (5) An institution which receives a rejection of its
- 22 affidavit may submit a corrected or new affidavit for review
- 23 <u>and acceptance by the department at any time.</u>
- (e) Five-year plan.--
- 25 (1) Within 90 days of the effective date of the change
- in designation, the institution must submit to the department
- 27 <u>a five-year plan to fulfill any additional unit or other</u>
- requirement needed for compliance with the definition of
- 29 <u>"university."</u>
- 30 (2) Failure of the institution to complete the plan

- 1 within five years from the effective date of the change in
- 2 <u>designation shall result in the institution losing its</u>
- 3 university status. The department may extend the time,
- 4 provided that the institution demonstrates progress toward
- 5 <u>fulfillment of the plan.</u>
- 6 (f) Definitions. -- The following words and phrases when used
- 7 <u>in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this</u>
- 8 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 9 "Institution." An institution of higher education in this
- 10 Commonwealth.
- "University." A multiunit institution with a complex
- 12 structure and diverse educational functions, including
- 13 <u>instruction</u>, <u>promotion</u> of <u>scholarship</u>, <u>preservation</u> and
- 14 discovery of knowledge, research and service, that:
- 15 (1) Consists of a minimum of three units as follows:
- 16 (i) The first unit provides for at least one major
- in both the arts and sciences at the undergraduate level.
- 18 (ii) The second unit provides for advanced degree
- 19 programs in the arts and sciences with at least one major
- in both the arts and sciences at the undergraduate level.
- 21 (iii) The third unit provides for any combination of
- 22 at least five advanced degrees or professional programs
- at the graduate level.
- 24 (2) Has a foundation in the arts and sciences which is
- 25 instilled in the philosophy and implementation of the
- 26 undergraduate and graduate education curriculum.
- 27 (3) Provides access to cultural facilities and
- opportunities to the community and utilizes similar assets of
- 29 the community.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
