1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for accidents involving death or personal injury.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3742(b)(3) of Title 75 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the subsection
8	is amended by adding paragraphs to read:
9	§ 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.

11	(b) Penalties
12	* * *
13	(3) (i) If the victim dies, any person violating
14	subsection (a) commits a felony of the second degree, and the
15	sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum
16	term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a
17	mandatory minimum fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other
18	provision of law.

1 (ii) In addition to the minimum term of imprisonment 2 provided for in subparagraph (i), the Pennsylvania 3 Commission on Sentencing shall provide within its quidelines a sentencing enhancement if the victim dies as 4 the result of a violation of subsection (a). [The 5 provisions of this subparagraph shall not be an element 6 7 of the crime, and notice of the provisions of this 8 subparagraph shall not be required prior to conviction, 9 but reasonable notice of the Commonwealth's intention to proceed under this subparagraph shall be provided after 10 11 conviction and before sentencing.] 12 (4) For each victim, the court shall impose an 13 additional fine and consecutive minimum term of imprisonment 14 as provided in this subsection. 15 (5) In addition to the minimum terms of imprisonment provided for in paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4), the 16 17 Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing shall provide within 18 its quidelines a sentencing enhancement if the person 19 convicted under this section is also convicted of a violation 20 of section 3802 (relating to driving under influence of 21 alcohol or controlled substance) that occurred concurrently 22 with the violation of this section. This enhanced term of_ 23 imprisonment shall be served consecutively. * * * 24 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
