AN ACT

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Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
    Consolidated Statutes, in veteran-owned small businesses,
    further providing for participation goal; and imposing duties
    of Bureau of Small Business Opportunities.
    The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
    Section 1. Section 9603 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
$ 9603. Participation [goal] requirement.
    A Statewide annual [goal] requirement of not less than [3%]
5% participation by veteran-owned small businesses, including
service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses, is established
for small business contracts issued under 62 Pa.C.S. (relating
to procurement). The participation [goal] requirement shall
apply to the total value of all contracts available to small
businesses in each fiscal year.
    Section 2. Title 51 is amended by adding a section to read:
$ 9604.1. Duties of Bureau of Small Business Opportunities.
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The Bureau of Small Business Opportunities shall:
(1) Implement and administer a Veteran-owned Small Business Procurement Initiative designed to ensure that Commonwealth agencies, executive agencies and purchasing agencies substantially increase opportunities for veteranowned businesses and service-disabled veteran-owned businesses as provided in this chapter.
(2) Establish a certification process for veteran-owned small businesses.
(3) Establish, maintain and administer a public list of veteran-owned small businesses that are certified by the Department of General Services. Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
