A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of September 22 through 28, 2014, as
2 "Respite Care Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Families are this Commonwealth's most important and
4 constant care providers for individuals with extraordinary care
5 needs, such as developmental disabilities, physical
6 disabilities, Alzheimer's disease, mental and emotional
7 disorders and extreme medical needs; and

8 WHEREAS, This important job can be stressful for the
9 individual providing care, particularly due to the often
10 constant demands, and many times involves a commitment of 24
11 hours a day; and

12 WHEREAS, Respite or relief from the intensive demands of
13 ongoing care keeps families intact and strengthens their ability
14 to meet the challenge of caring for a family member with special
15 needs; and

16 WHEREAS, Respite care is one of the most requested and cost-
17 effective services for families and caregivers; and

1 WHEREAS, Respite care helps prevent abuse and neglect by
2 giving stressed caregivers a break; and

3 WHEREAS, Citizens who provide respite care to persons with
4 special needs are providing an important and highly valuable
5 service to those individuals and their families and to their
6 communities; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of September 22
8 through 28, 2014, as "Respite Care Week" in Pennsylvania.
