Designating a section THE INTERCHANGE of State Route 43 at the Mon-Fayette Expressway Interchange with State Route 88, known 2 as Exit 28, in Fayette WASHINGTON County as the Marine Cpl. <--Thomas R. Matty Memorial Interchange-; DESIGNATING A BRIDGE <--ON THAT PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 1013, KNOWN AS KNUPP ROAD, OVER THE HYPOCRITE CREEK, FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND 5 6 COUNTY, AS THE PFC LEROY D. "WHITEY" SCHALLER BRIDGE; AND 7 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 711 IN NEW FLORENCE BOROUGH THROUGH ST. CLAIR TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, AS 9 THE VETERANS HIGHWAY. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty Memorial Interchange. 14 Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as 15 follows: 16 Thomas Richard Matty was born on October 4, 1945, in 17 Denbo, Pennsylvania. 18 He was a 1963 graduate of Bethlehem Center High

- 1 School where he excelled in many sports, especially baseball.
- 2 He received a business administration degree from the
- 3 Educational Institute of Pittsburgh in 1965.
- 4 (3) Thomas R. Matty enlisted in the United States Marine
- 5 Corps in 1966. He attended boot camp training at Parris
- 6 Island and additional training at Camp Lejeune and at El
- 7 Toro, California. He arrived in Vietnam on November 9, 1967.
- 8 (4) Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty made the ultimate
- 9 sacrifice for his country when he was killed in the vicinity
- of Quang Nam Province in South Vietnam on December 21, 1967,
- 11 at 22 years of age.
- 12 (5) Bethlehem Center High School continues to honor
- 13 Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty by giving an award to a senior
- 14 class member in his honor.
- 15 (b) Designation.--The section INTERCHANGE of State Route 43 <--

- 19 (c) Signs.--The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission shall erect
- 20 and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the

- 22 SECTION 2. PFC LEROY D. "WHITEY" SCHALLER MEMORIAL BRIDGE.
- 23 (A) DESIGNATION. -- THE BRIDGE LOCATED ON STATE ROUTE 1013,
- 24 KNOWN AS KNUPP ROAD, OVER THE HYPOCRITE CREEK, IN FAIRFIELD
- 25 TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED THE PFC
- 26 LEROY D. "WHITEY" SCHALLER BRIDGE.
- 27 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
- 28 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE BRIDGE TO
- 29 TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS ON THE BRIDGE.
- 30 SECTION 3. VETERANS HIGHWAY.

- 1 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 711 COMMENCING
- 2 AT THE INTERSECTION OF LIGONIER STREET AND 13TH STREET IN NEW
- 3 FLORENCE BOROUGH, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, AND CONTINUING THROUGH
- 4 ST. CLAIR TOWNSHIP AT THE SEWARD BOROUGH LINE, IS HEREBY
- 5 DESIGNATED THE VETERANS HIGHWAY.
- 6 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
- 7 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE HIGHWAY TO
