18	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

1	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
2	context clearly indicates otherwise:
3	"Political subdivision." A county, city, borough,
4	incorporated town, township, school district, vocational school,
5	county institution district, and an authority, entity or body
6	organized by any of them.
7	"Public employee." An individual employed by the
8	Commonwealth or a political subdivision.
9	"Public official." A person elected by the public or elected
10	or appointed by a governmental body or an appointed official in
11	the executive, legislative or judicial branch of this
12	Commonwealth or a political subdivision thereof.

14	<u>A public official or public employee who operates a</u>
15	government vehicle shall annually provide proof to the
16	respective governmental body or employer responsible for the
17	vehicle that the public official or public employee holds a
