1 2 3 4	Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in veterans' pensions and benefits, further providing for blind veteran's pension and for amputee and paralyzed veteran's pension.

7	Section 1. Section 7701(b) of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 7701. Blind veteran's pension.

11	(b) Amount and eligibilityIn addition to any other
12	assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any
13	compensation provided by the Federal Government, every blind
14	veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] <u>\$200</u> per month.
15	Applications for such pensions shall be made to and in the form
16	prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall have
17	the power, and it shall be his duty to determine the eligibility

1 of every applicant for a pension, and his decision in the matter 2 shall be final.

3 Section 2. Section 7702 of Title 51, amended October 22,
4 2014 (P.L.2838, No.180), is amended to read:

5 § 7702. Amputee and paralyzed veteran's pension.

(a) Amount and eligibility.--In addition to any other 6 7 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any 8 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every amputee and paralyzed veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$200 per 9 10 month. Applications for the pensions shall be made to and in the form prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall 11 determine the eligibility of every applicant for a pension, and 12 13 his decision in the matter shall be final.

15 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
