AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in human services block 2 3 grant pilot program, further providing for allocation. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Allocation. 10 11 Allocation. -- The department shall allocate State block grant funds to counties as follows: 12 13 The department shall allocate State block grant 14 funds according to each county's proportional share of the 15 aggregate amount of the following State funds allocated for 16 fiscal year 2011-2012:

_7	(1.1) The department shall allocate State block grant
L 8	funds according to the following formula:
_9	(i) Seventy-five percent based on county population.
20	(ii) Five percent based on population growth from
21	2000 through 2013 for those counties whose population
22	growth was above the State average.
23	(iii) Five percent based on poverty for those
24	counties whose level of poverty is above the State
25	average.
26	(iv) Five percent based on unemployment rate for
27	those counties whose unemployment rate is above the State
28	average.
29	(v) Five percent based on the square miles in the
30	county.

1	(vi) Five percent shall be allocated to a separate
2	dedicated account to be used specifically for counties
3	experiencing a distinct emergency that causes a budget
4	shortfall.

- (2) The department shall allocate Federal block grant funds to counties according to each county's fiscal year 2011-2012 proportional share of each Federal appropriation associated with the funds identified in paragraph (1).
- (3) Funds identified in paragraphs (1) and (2) that were allocated to county local collaborative arrangements shall be allocated to individual counties based on the individual county population.
- (4) The department may revise the allocation of Federal funds identified in paragraph (2) as necessary to comply with applicable Federal requirements.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
