AN ACT

- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The definition of "approval" in section 2 of the
- 8 act of July 9, 2013 (P.L.362, No.54), known as the Development
- 9 Permit Extension Act, is amended to read:
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Approval." Any of the following:
- 15 (1) [Except] <u>except</u> as provided in [paragraph]
- 16 <u>paragraphs</u> (2), (3) and (4), any government agency approval,
- 17 agreement, permit, including a building permit or
- 18 construction permit, or other authorization or decision:

1 (i) allowing a development or construction project 2 to proceed; or 3 (ii) relating to or affecting development, granted pursuant to a statute, regulation or ordinance adopted by 4 a municipality, including the following: 5 (A) 37 Pa.C.S. (relating to historical and 6 7 museums). (B) 53 Pa.C.S. (relating to municipalities 8 9 generally). 10 (C) 68 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Subpt. B (relating to 11 condominiums). 12 68 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Subpt. C (relating to 13 cooperatives). 14 68 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Subpt. D (relating to 15 planned communities).
