[A TRAILER DESIGNED OR ADAPTED AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.] A VEHICLE PRIMARILY 4 DESIGNED AS TEMPORARY LIVING QUARTERS FOR RECREATIONAL, CAMPING 5 OR TRAVEL USE, WHICH EITHER HAS ITS OWN POWER OR IS MOUNTED ON 6 7 OR DRAWN BY ANOTHER VEHICLE. THE TERM INCLUDES A TRAVEL TRAILER, 8 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK TRAILER, SLIDE-IN CAMPER, CAMPING 9 TRAILER AND MOTOR HOME. 10 "RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK TRAILER." A VEHICLE THAT IS BUILT <u>ON A SINGLE CHASSIS MOUNTED ON WHEELS, HAS A GROSS TRAILER AREA</u> 11 12 NOT EXCEEDING 400 SQUARE FEET IN THE SET-UP MODE AND IS

13 CERTIFIED BY THE MANUFACTURER AS COMPLYING WITH ANSI A119.5.

15 SECTION 2. SECTION 1138(A) OF TITLE 75 IS AMENDED TO READ: 16 § 1138. Duration of perfection.

17 (a) General rule.--Perfection of a security interest is 18 effective for a period of 30 years in the case of a mobile home 19 or emergency vehicle, 20 years for a motor home or recreational 20 trailer, eight years in the case of a truck tractor or trailer weighing in excess of 10,000 pounds and six years in all other 21 cases, in each case dating from the time of perfection as 22 23 provided for in this subchapter and subject to renewal as 24 provided in subsection (b).
