## AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, providing for the exclusion of
  veterans' benefit payments from income for Commonwealth
  programs.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 14 § 9801. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Commonwealth program." A program administered by the
- 2 Commonwealth that requires, as a condition for eligibility, the
- 3 inclusion of an individual's income.
- 4 <u>"Veteran." An individual who served in the United States</u>
- 5 Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard,
- 6 and who was discharged from that service under conditions other
- 7 than dishonorable.
- 8 <u>"Veterans' benefit payment." A service-connected</u>
- 9 compensation or payment which is earned by an individual as a
- 10 result of the individual's status as a veteran.
- 11 § 9802. Exclusion.
- 12 (a) General rule. -- Only 50% of a veterans' benefit payment
- 13 may be included as income for any Commonwealth program.
- 14 (b) Extension to spouses. -- The exclusion under this section
- 15 shall apply to an unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of a
- 16 <u>veteran for any compensation or payment the unmarried surviving</u>
- 17 spouse is entitled to receive.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
