AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in obstructing governmental
- operations, providing for unlawful use of an audio or video
- 4 device in court.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5103.1. Unlawful use of an audio or video device in court.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits a misdemeanor of the
- 11 second degree if the person in any manner and for any purpose
- 12 uses or operates a device to capture, record, transmit or
- 13 broadcast a photograph, video, motion picture or audio of a
- 14 proceeding or person within a hearing room, courtroom or the
- 15 environs of a hearing room or courtroom without the approval of
- 16 the court or presiding judicial officer or except as provided by
- 17 rules of court.
- 18 (b) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term

- 1 <u>"environs" means the area immediately surrounding any entrance</u>
- 2 or exit.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
