An ATV not bearing a certification label 3 conforming to ANSI/SVIA 1 - 2010 operated in this Commonwealth by a person eight or nine years of age shall have an engine size 4 of 70cc or less. 5 \* \* \* 6 7 (D) FAILURE TO EXHIBIT CERTIFICATE.-- [THE FAILURE OF SUCH A <--8 YOUTHFUL OPERATOR TO EXHIBIT THE APPROPRIATE SAFETY CERTIFICATE, 9 UPON DEMAND, TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER HAVING AUTHORITY TO 10 ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PRESUMPTIVE EVIDENCE THAT SUCH PERSON IS NOT THE HOLDER OF SUCH 11 CERTIFICATE.] WITHIN FIVE DAYS OF RECEIVING NOTICE OF A 12 13 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, A YOUTHFUL OPERATOR SHALL PRESENT THE 14 APPROPRIATE SAFETY CERTIFICATE THAT WAS VALID AT THE TIME OF DEMAND AT THE OFFICE OF THE ISSUING AUTHORITY. MUFFLERS AND [NOISE] SOUND CONTROL. 19 20 (A) GENERAL RULE.--IT IS UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE OR AN ATV WHICH IS NOT EQUIPPED AT ALL TIMES WITH A MUFFLER IN GOOD 21 WORKING ORDER WHICH BLENDS THE EXHAUST [NOISE] SOUND INTO THE 22 23 OVERALL SNOWMOBILE OR ATV [NOISE] SOUND AND IS IN CONSTANT 24 OPERATION TO PREVENT EXCESSIVE OR UNUSUAL NOISE. THE EXHAUST 25 SYSTEM SHALL NOT EMIT OR PRODUCE A SHARP POPPING OR CRACKLING SOUND. THE SOUND INTENSITY PRODUCED BY A SNOWMOBILE SHALL NOT 26 27 EXCEED 82DBA WHEN MEASURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAE RECOMMENDED 28 PRACTICE J 192 EXTERIOR SOUND LEVEL FOR SNOWMOBILES, AS AMENDED. 29 THE DEPARTMENT MAY BY REGULATION ADOPT MORE STRINGENT NOISE REQUIREMENTS FOR SNOWMOBILES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BY REGULATION 30 20150HB1703PN2849 - 2 -

1 ADOPT NOISE REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-USE OPERATION OF ATV'S USING 2 MEASUREMENT PROCEDURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANSI/SAE RECOMMENDED 3 PRACTICE J 1287 [MARCH 1982] JULY 1998, MEASUREMENT OF EXHAUST LEVEL OF STATIONARY MOTORCYCLES. THE SOUND LEVEL INTENSITY 4 PRODUCED BY AN ATV MANUFACTURED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1998, SHALL 5 NOT EXCEED 99DBA, OR DECIBELS, WHEN MEASURED AT 20 INCHES. THE 6 7 SOUND LEVEL INTENSITY PRODUCED BY AN ATV MANUFACTURED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1998, SHALL NOT EXCEED 96DBA, OR DECIBELS, WHEN 8 9 MEASURED AT 20 INCHES. \* \* \* 10

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
