AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for
- qualifications to register, for government agencies and for
- 4 preparation and distribution of applications.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 1301(a), 1325(b)(4) and 1327(a)(4)(iii)
- 8 and (b)(1) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
- 9 are amended to read:
- 10 § 1301. Qualifications to register.
- 11 (a) Eligibility. -- An individual who will be at least 18
- 12 years of age on the day of the next election, who has been a
- 13 citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the
- 14 next election and who has resided in this Commonwealth and the
- 15 election district where the individual offers to vote for at
- 16 least 30 days prior to the next ensuing election [and has not
- 17 been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a
- 18 felony within the last five years] shall be eligible to register

- 1 as provided in this chapter.

- 3 § 1325. Government agencies.
- 4 * * *
- 5 (b) Forms. -- An agency designated in subsection (a) shall
- 6 provide a form for office visits or, if the agency provides
- 7 services to persons with disabilities, for home visits which
- 8 contains all of the following:

- 10 (4) The statement "In order to be qualified to register
- 11 to vote, you must be at least 18 years of age on the day of
- 12 the next election, <u>and</u> you must have been a citizen of the
- 13 United States for at least one month prior to the next
- 14 election and have resided in Pennsylvania and the election
- district where you plan to vote for at least 30 days prior to
- the next election[, and you must not have been confined in a
- 17 penal institution for a conviction of a felony within the
- 18 last five years]."

- 20 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.
- 21 (a) Form.--
- 22 * * *
- 23 (4) A voter registration application shall be printed on
- stock of good quality and shall be of suitable uniform size.
- Nothing in this part shall prohibit the design and use of an
- 26 electronic voter registration application which includes the
- applicant's digitized or electronic signature. The
- registration application shall contain the following
- 29 information; however, the information may be provided on a
- 30 separate form for voter registration made under section 1323

3 Notice that the applicant must be a citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the 4 5 next election and a resident of this Commonwealth and the election district for at least 30 days and must be at 6 7 least 18 years of age by the day of the next ensuing 8 election [and has not been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a felony within the last 9 10 five years]. The notice required in this subparagraph 11 shall be in print identical to the declaration under 12 subsection (b).

- (b) Registration declaration. --
- 15 (1) The official voter registration application shall 16 contain a registration declaration. On the declaration, the 17 applicant shall state all of the following:
 - (i) The applicant has been a citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the next election.
 - (ii) On the day of the next ensuing election, the applicant shall be at least 18 years of age.
 - (iii) On the day of the next ensuing election, the applicant shall have resided in this Commonwealth and in the election district for at least 30 days.
 - [(iv) The applicant has not been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a felony within the last five years.]
- 28 (v) The applicant is legally qualified to vote.

- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
