## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled, as 1 amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety by 2 providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits 3 for those who desire to engage in the profession of 4 cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology 5 salons, schools, students, apprentices, teachers, managers, 6 7 manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational 8 Affairs of the Department of State; providing for appeals to 9 certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing 10 penalties," further providing for student practice upon the 11 public for pay prohibited. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, amended June 30, 16 1984 (P.L.479, No.100), is amended to read: 17 18 Section 7. Student Practice upon the Public for Pay 19 Prohibited.--It shall be unlawful for any school of cosmetology 20 to permit its students to practice cosmetology upon the public under any circumstances except by way of clinical work upon 21

1 persons willing to submit themselves to such practice after having first been properly informed that the operator is a 2 student. [No school of cosmetology shall, directly or 3 indirectly, charge any money whatsoever for treatment by its 4 students and shall only charge the reasonable cost of materials 5 used in such treatment.] <u>A school of cosmetology shall be</u> 6 permitted to charge the public a reasonable fee for cosmetology\_ 7 services performed by students in their clinical training and 8 9 education.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
