4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2710 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 2710. Ethnic and employment intimidation.
9	(a) Offense definedA person commits the offense of ethnic
10	and employment intimidation if, with malicious intention toward
11	the race, color, religion [or], national origin <u>or employment as</u>
12	a law enforcement officer of another individual or group of
13	individuals, he commits an offense under any other provision of
14	this article or under Chapter 33 (relating to arson, criminal
15	mischief and other property destruction) exclusive of section
16	3307 (relating to institutional vandalism) or under section 3503
17	(relating to criminal trespass) with respect to such individual
18	or his or her property or with respect to one or more members of

1 such group or to their property.

(b) Grading.--An offense under this section shall be
classified as a misdemeanor of the third degree if the other
offense is classified as a summary offense. Otherwise, an
offense under this section shall be classified one degree higher
in the classification specified in section 106 (relating to
classes of offenses) than the classification of the other
offense.

9 (c) [Definition.--As used in this section "malicious 10 intention" means the] <u>Definitions.--As used in this section, the</u> 11 <u>following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to</u> 12 <u>them in this subsection unless the context clearly indicates</u> 13 otherwise:

14 "Law enforcement officer." A person who by virtue of his office or public employment is vested by law with a duty to 15 16 maintain public order or to make arrests for offenses, whether that duty extends to all offenses or is limited to specific 17 18 offenses, or any person on active State duty under 51 Pa.C.S. § 19 508 (relating to active duty for emergency). The term includes a corrections officer, a parole agent and a member of a park 20 police department in a county of the third class. 21 22 "Malicious intention." The intention to commit any act, the 23 commission of which is a necessary element of any offense 24 referred to in subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the race, color, religion [or], national origin or employment as a 25 law enforcement officer of another individual or group of 26 individuals. 27

28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
