AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 20, 2016 (P.L.813, No.90), entitled "An
 2 act designating a portion of State Route 74 in Cumberland
 3 County as the Marine Lance Corporal Gary Lee Ream Memorial
 4 Highway; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route
 5 4010 over the Sugar Creek, Sugarcreek Borough, Venango
 6 County, as the Lieutenant Andrew J. White Memorial Bridge;
 7 designating a portion of State Route 220 in Lycoming and
 8 Sullivan Counties as the Lieutenant Commander John J.
 9 Peterman Memorial Highway; designating a portion of State
 10 Route 220 in Lycoming County as the Thomas A. Paternostro
 11 Memorial Highway; designating a bridge on that portion of
 12 State Route 74 over the Sherman's Creek, Spring Township,
 13 Perry County, as the PFC William Oscar Stambaugh Memorial
 14 Bridge; designating a portion of State Route 309 in Upper
 15 Saucon Township, Lehigh County, as the Officer David M.
 16 Petzold Memorial Highway; designating the pedestrian walkways
 17 on the Matsonford Bridge, located on State Route 3016 over
 18 the Schuylkill River, connecting the Boroughs of West
 19 Conshohocken and Conshohocken, Montgomery County, as the
 20 Clay-Doc Walk in memory of West Conshohocken Borough Police
 21 Chief Joseph G. Clayborne III and Conshohocken Borough Police
 22 Chief James H. Dougherty, Sr.; and designating a portion of
 23 State Route 1030 in the Borough of Donora, Washington County,
 24 as the Ken Griffey Sr. & Jr. Drive," further providing for
 25 Lieutenant Commander John J. Peterman Memorial Highway and
 26 for Thomas A. Paternostro Memorial Highway.

27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 28 hereby enacts as follows:

29 Section 1. Sections 3(b) and 4(b) of the act of July 20,
 30 2016 (P.L.813, No.90), entitled "An act designating a portion of

8 Route 220 in Lycoming County as the Thomas A. Paternostro
9 Memorial Highway; designating a bridge on that portion of State
10 Route 74 over the Sherman's Creek, Spring Township, Perry
11 County, as the PFC William Oscar Stambaugh Memorial Bridge;
12 designating a portion of State Route 309 in Upper Saucon
13 Township, Lehigh County, as the Officer David M. Petzold
14 Memorial Highway; designating the pedestrian walkways on the
15 Matsonford Bridge, located on State Route 3016 over the
16 Schuylkill River, connecting the Boroughs of West Conshohocken
17 and Conshohocken, Montgomery County, as the Clay-Doc Walk in
18 memory of West Conshohocken Borough Police Chief Joseph G.
19 Clayborne III and Conshohocken Borough Police Chief James H.
20 Dougherty, Sr.; and designating a portion of State Route 1030 in
21 the Borough of Donora, Washington County, as the Ken Griffey Sr.
22 & Jr. Drive," are amended to read:

23 Section 3. Lieutenant Commander John J. Peterman Memorial
24 Highway.

26 (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 220 from State
27 Route [405] 2081 in [Hughesville Borough] Shrewsbury Township,
28 Lycoming County, to State Route 42 in Laporte Township, Sullivan
29 County, is hereby designated as the Lieutenant Commander John J.
30 Peterman Memorial Highway.

2 Section 4. Thomas A. Paternostro Memorial Highway.

4 (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 220 in Lycoming
5 County from State Route [2081] 405 in [Wolf Township to State
6 Route 42 in Hughesville Borough] Hughesville Borough to the
7 Picture Rocks Borough line is hereby designated the Thomas A.
8 Paternostro Memorial Highway.
