A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing January 8, 2015, as the 200th anniversary of the
2 Battle of New Orleans.

3 WHEREAS, The Battle of New Orleans was a series of
4 engagements fought December 24, 1814, through January 8, 1815,
5 and was the final major battle of the War of 1812; and

6 WHEREAS, The Battle of New Orleans involved 7,500 British
7 soldiers and 4,500 American troops; and

8 WHEREAS, The American combatants, commanded by Major General
9 Andrew Jackson, prevented an invading British Army and Royal
10 Navy from seizing New Orleans as a strategic tool to end the war
11 and defeat the United States; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize January
13 8, 2015, as the 200th anniversary of the Battle of New Orleans.
