A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing 2015 as the "Year of the Borinqueneers" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "The Borinqueneers" is a nickname for the 65th
- 4 Infantry Regiment of the 3rd Division in the United States Army,
- 5 an all-volunteer Puerto Rican unit that participated in World
- 6 War I, World War II and the Korean War; and
- WHEREAS, The nickname was derived from the word boringuen,
- 8 which means land of the brave lord or land of the pure; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The unit was founded in 1899 and remained a vital
- 10 part of the United States Armed Forces until 1956, when the
- 11 regiment was deactivated; and
- 12 WHEREAS, This distinctive military unit served in multiple
- 13 conflicts and its members were known for their fierce fighting
- 14 spirit; and
- 15 WHEREAS, In all, 61,000 Puerto Ricans served in the United
- 16 States Army during the Korean War, many of whom were with the

- 1 65th Infantry Regiment; and
- 2 WHEREAS, By the time the regiment was deactivated, more than
- 3 750 Boringueneers had died and 2,400 had been wounded in the
- 4 Korean War alone; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 1959, the regiment became the only regular Army
- 6 unit to have ever been transferred to the National Guard when
- 7 the regiment's 1st battalion and regimental number were assigned
- 8 to the Puerto Rico National Guard, which is where the 65th
- 9 Infantry Regiment still serves; and
- 10 WHEREAS, During World War II, the regiment earned 2 Silver
- 11 Stars, 22 Bronze Stars and 90 Purple Hearts and during the
- 12 Korean War, the Boringueneers earned 1 Medal of Honor, 10
- 13 Distinguished Service Crosses, 256 Silver Stars, 606 Bronze
- 14 Stars and 2,771 Purple Hearts; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Their commitment and courage are deserving of this
- 16 country's praise and gratitude; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend the 65th
- 18 Infantry Regiment for its outstanding dedication and service to
- 19 the United States Armed Forces and recognize 2015 as the "Year
- 20 of the Borinqueneers" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared for the
- 22 regiment as an expression of esteem from the House of
- 23 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
