## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the establishment of Forest 2 Fire Wardens in this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, There are approximately 2.2 million acres of State
- 4 forest lands and 17 million acres of woodlands that stretch
- 5 across this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Wildfire threatens these areas, especially during
- 7 the spring and fall; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In order to preserve these natural resources, the
- 9 Commonwealth relies on about 1,600 people who serve as volunteer
- 10 forest fire wardens; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania forest fire warden system was
- 12 established by the act of June 3, 1915 (P.L.797, No.353),
- 13 referred to as the Forest Fire Protection Act; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Forest fire wardens in this Commonwealth actively
- 2 promote fire prevention in their communities and often visit
- 3 schools and civic groups in a Statewide team effort that in 2013
- 4 earned them recognition from the Forest Service of the United
- 5 States Department of Agriculture; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The efforts of forest fire wardens are worthy of
- 7 formal recognition by the Commonwealth during the 100th
- 8 anniversary of their founding; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate the
- 10 100th Anniversary of the establishment of Forest Fire Wardens in
- 11 this Commonwealth.
