A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the week of May 4 through 8, 2015, as "Small Business Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Every year since 1963, the President of the United
4	States has issued a proclamation announcing "National Small
5	Business Week," which recognizes the critical contributions of
6	America's entrepreneurs and small business owners; and
7	WHEREAS, Small businesses create about two out of every three
8	new jobs in this country each year; and
9	WHEREAS, More than half of Americans either own or work for a
10	small business; and
11	WHEREAS, Small businesses make up 98.2% of all employers in
12	this Commonwealth; and

1 WHEREAS, Small businesses helped this Commonwealth attain a 2 5.1% unemployment rate in January 2015, which was lower than the 3 national average of 5.7%; and

WHEREAS, Small businesses employ approximately half, or 2.4
million, of this Commonwealth's private workforce; and
WHEREAS, The 234,540 small businesses in this Commonwealth
produce more than \$77.4 billion in annual income, including
benefits; and

9 WHEREAS, More small business owners are anticipating economic 10 expansion in the coming year than at any point in the last seven 11 years; and

12 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's commitment to small business 13 development and advancement is clear in many ways, such as the 14 work of the Pennsylvania Office of Small Business Advocate; and 15 WHEREAS, The ongoing work of the Pennsylvania Office of Small Business Advocate afforded an estimated \$34.5 million in savings 16 17 realized by this Commonwealth's small business utility 18 customers; and 19 WHEREAS, Most new jobs that are created in this Commonwealth 20 are in small businesses; therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 22 week of May 4 through 8, 2015, as "Small Business Week" in 23 Pennsylvania.
