- 4 (SJS) Foundation has remained true to its mission and goal of
- 5 providing support, education and advocacy through the
- 6 compilation and distribution of valuable information about SJS
- 7 to the public and medical professionals regarding treatments and
- 8 therapies; and
- 9 WHEREAS, SJS and toxic epidermal necrolysis syndrome, another
- 10 form of SJS, are severe allergic reactions to prescription and
- 11 over-the-counter medications; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Those afflicted with SJS experience severe
- 13 inflammation of the mucus membranes and, if left untreated, SJS
- 14 can result in blindness, other serious health problems and
- 15 death; therefore be it
