- 5 WHEREAS, As led by the Academy of American Poets, "National
- 6 Poetry Month" has become the largest literary celebration in the
- 7 world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, "National Poetry Month" highlights the extraordinary
- 9 legacy and ongoing achievement of American poets; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "National Poetry Month" introduces Americans to the
- 11 pleasures and benefits of reading poetry; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Poets and poetry are made public in immediate and
- 13 innovative ways; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The importance of poetry in children's learning is
- 15 reinforced; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Poetry has generated some of our nation's leading
- 2 creative artists; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Poetry has inspired other artists in fields spanning
- 4 music, theater, film, dance and the visual arts; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Language arts, including poetry, integrate the
- 6 creative arts and humanities and reflect the educational,
- 7 economic and social fabric of our communities; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
