A RESOLUTION

- Designating May 2, 2016, as "School Bus Driver Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, School bus drivers in this Commonwealth are
- 4 responsible for safely transporting approximately 1.5 million
- 5 students to and from their schools on a daily basis; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 2015, there were more than 45,000 licensed school
- 7 bus drivers in this Commonwealth, driving more than 31,000
- 8 registered school buses; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In the 2013-2014 school year, school bus drivers in
- 10 this Commonwealth logged more than 300 million miles while
- 11 transporting children to school and school activities, including
- 12 field trips, sporting events and other extracurricular
- 13 activities; and
- 14 WHEREAS, School bus drivers take on the responsibility of
- 15 watching over the students riding on their buses, providing safe

- 1 travel and a safe atmosphere by seeking to prevent bullying and
- 2 other actions; and
- 3 WHEREAS, School bus drivers come from many different
- 4 backgrounds, from those looking for something to do in
- 5 retirement to those who choose school bus driving as a career;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The men and women who are school bus drivers are to
- 8 be commended for the job they do throughout the school year,
- 9 working in all types of weather, from early morning into the
- 10 evenings and at times on weekends, to transport students
- 11 throughout this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 2,
- 13 2016, as "School Bus Driver Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania.
