- Designating the month of May 2016 as "Military Service Opportunity Month" in Pennsylvania.

- 5 recognized as our nation's top security force and defender of
- 6 our national interests around the world; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The United States military is one of the leading
- 8 Federal organizations that supports and invests in educational
- 9 initiatives around the country; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The United States military contributes to the well-
- 11 being of students within this Commonwealth by offering personal
- 12 advancement through educational programs beginning at the high
- 13 school level; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The United States military has an outstanding
- 15 reputation for recruiting volunteers inspired by a sense of duty

- 2 greatest military force; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Generations of remarkable citizens have pledged to
- 4 defend our homeland and nation through service in the Army,
- 5 Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and Coast Guard, including
- 6 National Guard and Reserve components; and
- 7 WHEREAS, United States military members are academically and
- 8 professionally prepared to provide a multitude of career
- 9 services to our nation, including, but not limited to, a full
- 10 range of medical services, cyber security, law enforcement
- 11 services, comprehensive legal services, a full range of
- 12 engineering services, comprehensive satellite technology,
- 13 communications and network development and logistical and
- 14 administrative support; and
- 15 WHEREAS, As a valuable asset to all students, military
- 16 members work side-by-side with their civilian counterparts to
- 17 enhance the delivery of high-quality services to our youths; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Military recruiters provide educational programs
- 19 such as leadership development, antibullying, antidrug and
- 20 patriotism and those that enhance the science, technology,
- 21 engineering and math (STEM) curricula; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Military recruiters offer physical fitness
- 23 programming to all students to fight the obesity epidemic in the
- 24 United States; and
- 25 WHEREAS, The United States military has earned the respect of
- 26 the entire world as a leader of technology and personal
- 27 advancement though the protection and defense of civil
- 28 liberties; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Members of the United States military are recognized
- 30 for their dedication and contributions to people's lives and for

- 11 recognize the United States military for its significant impact
