A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing November 10, 2016, as "Marine Corps Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania in honor of the United States Marine Corps'
- 3 241st anniversary.
- 4 WHEREAS, The United States Marine Corps was founded as the
- 5 Continental Marines by a resolution passed by the Second
- 6 Continental Congress on November 10, 1775; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps has fought with great courage on
- 8 six continents and in every conflict in American history,
- 9 including the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, World War I,
- 10 World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps has also served in support of
- 12 Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan and Operation Iragi

- 1 Freedom; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps has fought valiantly in defense of
- 3 the United States and its citizens and principles; and
- 4 WHEREAS, There are approximately 201,000 active duty and
- 5 100,000 reserve members of the Marine Corps; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Marines recognize the Marine Corps as a tradition
- 7 built on time-honored values and principles; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Marines truly embody the motto of the Marine Corps:
- 9 Semper Fidelis which translates from Latin as "always faithful"
- 10 and signifies the defense of freedom and democracy worldwide;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, "Raising of the Flag on Iwo Jima," the famous
- 13 photograph by Joe Rosenthal, will always symbolize the triumph
- 14 and glory of the Marine Corps; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Marine Air Ground Task Force integrates a ground
- 16 combat element, an aviation combat element and a logistics
- 17 combat element under a common command element; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Known for its amphibious and land capabilities, the
- 19 Marine Air Ground Task Force operates independently or as part
- 20 of a larger coalition; and
- 21 WHEREAS, During World War I, Marines fought their famed
- 22 Battle at Belleau Wood, establishing their reputation for
- 23 toughness and fierceness; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps played a central role in the
- 25 liberation of the Pacific Islands during World War II; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The momentum of the Korean War shifted when the
- 27 Marine Corps, in conjunction with the Navy, launched a massive
- 28 amphibious attack at Inchon, surprising the North Koreans by
- 29 putting thousands of United States troops behind enemy lines;
- 30 and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps participated in major offensives of
- 2 the Vietnam Conflict, engaging in guerrilla warfare,
- 3 implementing unconventional techniques for counterinsurgency and
- 4 working as military advisors to the Republic of Vietnam Marine
- 5 Corps; and
- 6 WHEREAS, From 1990 to 1992, Marines participated in Operation
- 7 Desert Shield and Operation Desert Storm, leading the liberation
- 8 of Kuwait and the defeat of Iraqi forces; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps continues to make significant
- 10 contributions to the war on terrorism; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps supports peacekeeping missions and
- 12 humanitarian operations in countries such as Liberia,
- 13 Bangladesh, the Philippines and Somalia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Marine Corps Order No. 47, Series 192, written by
- 15 Lieutenant General John A. Lejeune, Major General Commandant of
- 16 the Marine Corps, established the mandatory celebration of the
- 17 Marine Corps' anniversary; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 19 November 10, 2016, as "Marine Corps Day" in Pennsylvania in
- 20 honor of the United States Marine Corps' 241st anniversary.
