11	Section 1. The act of November 6, 1987 (P.L.381, No.79),
12	known as the Older Adults Protective Services Act, is amended by

17	Section 601. Background checks for applicants and recipients.
18	<u>(a) Applicants</u>
19	(1) Prior to the admission of an applicant to a facility
20	as a resident, the facility shall perform a search for the

1	applicant's name on the Pennsylvania State Police registry of
2	offenders and sexually violent predators established under 42
3	<u>Pa.C.S. § 9799.28 (relating to public Internet website).</u>
4	(2) Prior to the admission of an applicant who
5	previously resided outside this Commonwealth to a facility as
6	a resident, the facility shall perform a search for the
7	applicant's name on the Dru Sjodin National Sex Offender
8	Public Website established under section 120 of the Adam
9	Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006 (Public Law
10	<u>109-248, 120 Stat. 587).</u>
11	(b) RecipientsWithin 30 days of the effective date of
12	this section, the facility shall search:
13	(1) The Pennsylvania State Police registry of offenders
14	and sexually violent predators established under 42 Pa.C.S. §
15	9799.28 using the names of recipients who are residents of
16	the facility as search criteria.
17	(2) The Dru Sjodin National Sex Offender Public Website
18	established under section 120 of the Adam Walsh Child
19	Protection and Safety Act of 2006 using the names of
20	recipients who are residents of the facility who previously
21	resided outside this Commonwealth as search criteria.
22	Section 602. Information relating to applicants and recipients.
23	In no case may a facility admit an applicant as a resident or
24	retain a recipient as a resident if it finds the applicant or
25	recipient listed on either:
26	(1) the Pennsylvania State Police registry of offenders
27	and sexually violent predators established under 42 Pa.C.S. §
28	<u>9799.28 (relating to public Internet website); or</u>
29	(2) the Dru Sjodin National Sex Offender Public Website
30	established under section 120 of the Adam Walsh Child
