AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in falsification and intimidation, 2 further providing for the offense of impersonating a notary 3 public or a holder of a professional or occupational license. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 4913(b)(1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and subsection (b) 8 9 is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 10 § 4913. Impersonating a notary public or a holder of a 11 professional or occupational license. 12 13 (b) Grading. --14 (1)Except as set forth in paragraph (2) or (3), an 15 offense under this section is a misdemeanor of the second 16 degree. * * * 17

(3) If the intent of the actor is to impersonate a

- doctor of medicine and, in so doing, the actor provides
- 2 <u>medical advice or treatment to another person as a patient,</u>
- 3 regardless of whether or not the other person suffers harm
- 4 <u>from the medical advice or treatment, an offense under this</u>
- 5 <u>section is a misdemeanor of the first degree.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
