9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 102 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
11	No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by
12	adding a definition to read:
13	Section 102. DefinitionsWhen used in this act the
14	following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:
15	* * *
16	"School security drill." An exercise, other than a fire
17	drill, to practice procedures that respond to an emergency
18	situation, including, but not limited to, a nonfire evacuation,
19	lockdown or active shooter situation that are similar in
20	duration to a fire drill.

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Section 2. Section 1517(d) of the act, amended January 14, 1970 (1969 P.L.468, No.192), is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 1517. Fire and Emergency Evacuation Drills. --* * * 5 6 (d) All schools using or contracting for school buses for the transportation of school children shall conduct on school 7 8 grounds two emergency evacuation drills on buses during each school year, the first to be conducted during the first week of 9 10 the first school term and the second during the month of March, and at such other times as the chief school administrator may 11 require. Each such drill shall include the practice and 12 13 instruction concerning the location, use and operation of 14 emergency exit doors and fire extinguishers and the proper 15 evacuation of buses in the event of fires or accidents. 16 Bus operators shall be provided with proper training and

17 instructions to enable them to carry out the provisions of this 18 subsection and may be required to attend classes and drills in 19 connection therewith.

20 On or before the tenth day of April of each year, each 21 district superintendent shall certify to the [Department of 22 Public Instruction] <u>Department of Education</u> that the emergency 23 evacuation drills herein required have been held.

24 (e) (1) In all public schools, school security drills shall

25 be periodically conducted not less than twice a year. The drills

26 may be in place of, or in addition to, two of the required

27 monthly fire drills. In the security drills, the pupils and

28 teachers shall be instructed in, and made thoroughly familiar

29 with, the steps to be taken in the event of an emergency

30 situation that does not involve a fire, including, but not

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1 limited to, a natural disaster, armed intruder	or building
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- 2 <u>collapse</u>.
- 3 (2) On or before the tenth day of April each year, each
- 4 <u>district superintendent shall certify to the Department of</u>
- 5 Education that the school security drills required under this
- 6 <u>section have been held.</u>
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
