## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further providing for registration, for reporting and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Sections 13A04(a), (d) and (e)(1), 13A05(a), (b)
8	(4), (6) and (8) and (d) and 13A10(c) of Title 65 of the
9	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 13A04. Registration.
11	(a) General ruleUnless excluded under section 13A06
12	(relating to exemption from registration and reporting), a
13	lobbyist, lobbying firm or a principal must register with the
14	department electronically using the computerized filing system
15	developed by the department that is consistent with the purposes
16	of this chapter within ten days of acting in any capacity as a
17	lobbyist, lobbying firm or principal. Registration shall be

biennial and shall begin January 1, 2007. 1

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3	(d) Amendments
4	(1) If there is a change of information required for the
5	registration statement under subsection (b)(1) or (2) or (c),
6	an amended registration statement shall be filed with the
7	department electronically using the computerized filing
8	system developed by the department that is consistent with
9	the purpose of this chapter within 14 days after the change
10	occurs.
11	(2) When there is a change in information required for
12	the registration statement under subsection (b)(3), an
13	amended registration statement shall be filed with the
14	department electronically using the computerized filing
15	system developed by the department that is consistent with
16	the purpose of this chapter within 14 days of the end of the
17	year in which the change occurs.
18	(e) Termination
19	(1) A lobbyist, lobbying firm or principal may terminate
20	registration by filing notice of termination with the
21	department[.] <u>electronically using the computerized filing</u>
22	system developed by the department that is consistent with
23	the purpose of this chapter.

25	§ 13A05. Reporting.
26	(a) General ruleA registered principal shall, under oath
27	or affirmation, file quarterly expense reports with the
28	department electronically using the computerized filing system
29	developed by the department that is consistent with the purpose

30 of this chapter no later than 30 days after the last day of the

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1 quarter.

2 (b) Content.--

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\* \* \*

A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a 4 (4) 5 lobbying firm shall sign the reports <u>electronically</u> submitted 6 by each principal for whom the lobbying firm or lobbyist is 7 registered to attest to the validity and accuracy to the best 8 of the attestor's knowledge. A lobbying firm or lobbyist may 9 attach a statement to the electronic report of a principal, 10 describing the limits of the knowledge of the lobbying firm 11 or lobbyist concerning the information contained in the 12 expense report.

14 (6) A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a 15 lobbying firm shall submit an expense report electronically 16 using the computerized filing system developed by the 17 department that is consistent with the purpose of this 18 chapter if during the reporting period the lobbying firm or 19 lobbyist engaged in lobbying which was not contained in any 20 expense report filed by a principal or principals 21 represented.

23 (8) A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a 24 lobbying firm shall submit a report electronically using the 25 computerized filing system developed by the department that 26 is consistent with the purpose of this chapter if the 27 lobbying firm or lobbyist engaged in lobbying on behalf of any entity that is exempt under section 13A06(7), (8), (9) or 28 29 (10) (relating to exemption from registration and reporting). \* \* \* 30

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1 (d) Thresholds for reporting. -- An expense report required under this section shall be filed <u>electronically using the</u> 2 computerized filing system developed by the department that is 3 consistent with the purpose of this chapter when total expenses 4 for lobbying exceed \$2,500 for a registered principal in a 5 reporting period. In a reporting period in which total expenses 6 7 are \$2,500 or less, a statement to that effect shall be filed 8 electronically using the computerized filing system developed by 9 the department that is consistent with the purpose of this 10 chapter. \* \* \* 11 12 § 13A10. Registration fees; fund established; system; 13 regulations. 14 \* \* \* 15 (c) Computerized filing system. -- The department shall 16 implement a fully accessible system to accommodate the use of 17 computerized filing. Each registrant shall elect on an annual 18 basis whether the registrant will file all of the documents 19 required by this chapter either electronically or on paper with 20 the department. The department shall post all filings on its 21 publicly accessible Internet website within seven days of 22 receipt of the filing. \* \* \* 23 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows: 25 The amendment of 65 Pa.C.S. §§ 13A04(a), (d) and (1)26 (e)(1) and 13A05(a), (b)(4), (6) and (8) and (d) shall take 27 effect January 1, 2016. The remainder of this act shall take effect 28 (2)29 immediately.

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
