11	(a) OffenseAn individual may not smoke in a vehicle which
12	is transporting a child under 12 years of age.
13	(b) Grading
14	(1) An individual who violates subsection (a) commits a
15	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
16	<u>pay a fine of \$100.</u>
17	(2) An individual who commits a second or subsequent
18	offense after being convicted under paragraph (1) commits a
19	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to

- 1 <u>pay a fine of \$250.</u>
- 2 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "smoke"
- 3 means to carry a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking
- 4 <u>device.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
